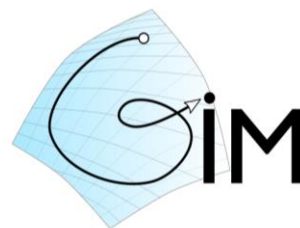


Graduate Inter-university Math Seminars
